Instructions for calling 911:

Identify yourself by name, and tell the operator that you are babysitting. Describe the problem, and calmly answer any questions the operator may ask you. The operator will notify a dispatcher as soon as they have your address. This happens automatically, so it is important to stay calm while on the phone. The operator may give you instructions to help you with the situation. Stay on the phone unless instructed to do otherwise. The people at 911 are trained professionals and will do everything possible to help you.
